B. Other Compliance Information

The Healthy Network Initiative spending period follows the CSG Spending Period (October 1, 2018 – September 30, 2020), pursuant to the 2019 Television Community Service Grant General Provisions and Eligibility Criteria (“General Provisions”). The General Provisions identify all eligibility requirements and permitted use and restrictions of the grantee’s CSG. The General Provisions and other applicable agreements governing the CSG are available at cpb.org/stations/.

C. Certification

This application must be executed by the licensee official and the head of the grantee. The licensee official is the chair of the Licensee’s governing board, or a designated senior level representative of the Licensee, who is not a member of the station’s management and who has the authority to enter into binding contracts and agreements on behalf of the Licensee (Licensee Official). The head of the grantee is the highest-ranking representative of the station’s management responsible for station operations, such as its president and chief executive officer (Head of Grantee).
